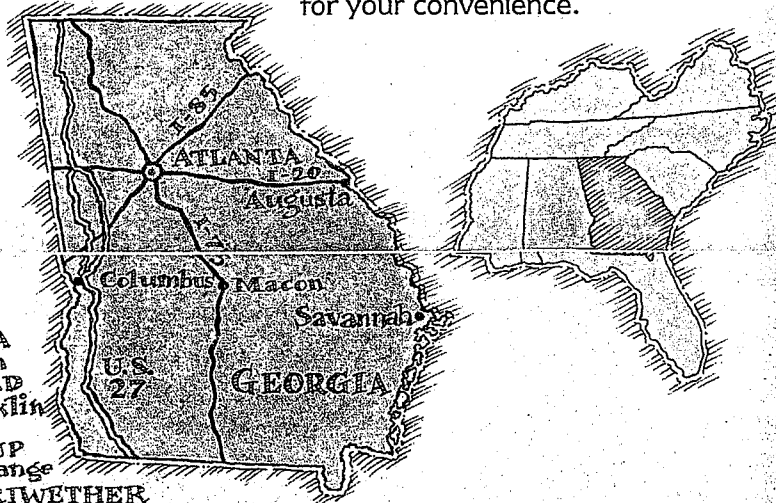
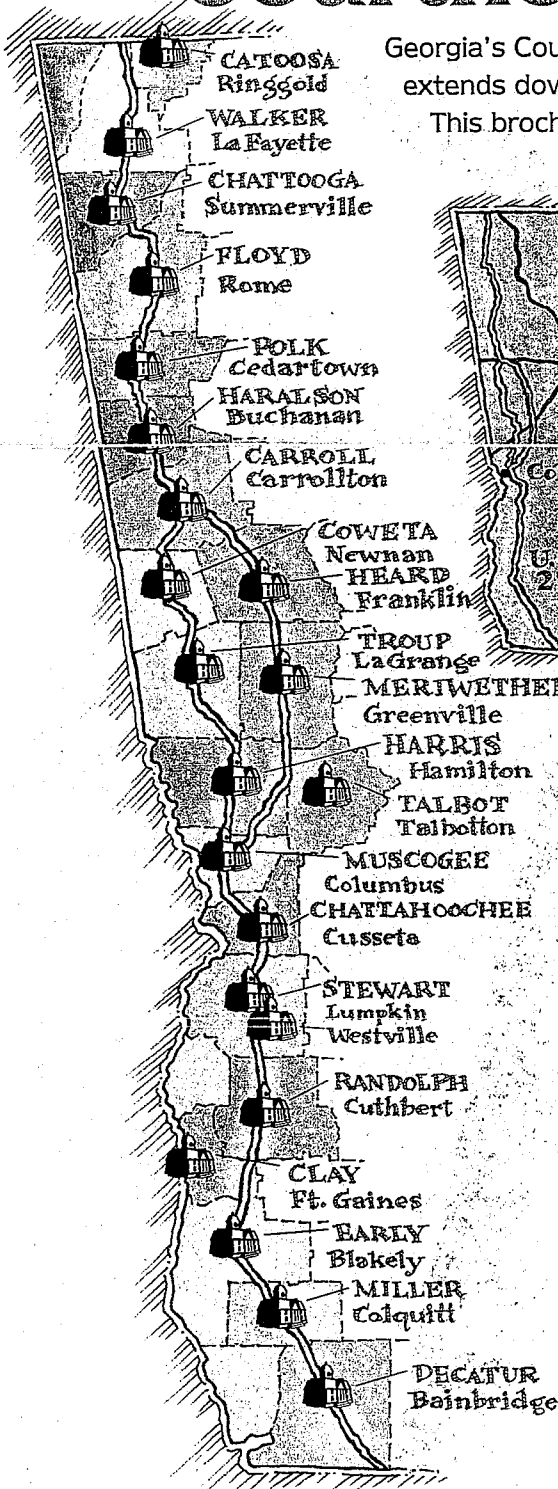


Georgia's Historic Courthouse Corridor
